

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-438

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

July 26, 2011

Hazardous Waste Remediation and Disposal

BACKGROUND

- A. The City of Sacramento is required by state and federal law to dispose of hazardous wastes generated by City operations every 90 days. The City must also respond to and properly dispose of hazardous materials abandoned in the public right of way within the City limits.
- B. It is in the best interest of the City of Sacramento to contract with PARC Specialty Contractors for hazardous waste remediation and disposal services due to the favorable pricing adopted from a high volume, competitively bid contract with the State of California, Department of Toxics Substances Control.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Competitive bidding is suspended for award of a hazardous waste remediation and disposal services contract with PARC Specialty Contractors.
- Section 2. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute an agreement for hazardous waste remediation and disposal services contract with PARC Specialty Contractors for a term of ten and one half months from August 15, 2011 until June 30, 2012.


