Description/Analysis

Issue: Parking on U and V Streets, between 45th and 48th Streets is currently regulated “No Parking 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Except with Permit.” During early morning and evening hours, non-residents, such as commuters, often park along those sections of U and V Streets making it difficult for residents and their guests to park near their homes.

Policy Considerations: This recommendation is consistent with the City’s strategic plan and the goal of the City Council to achieve sustainability and enhance livability.

Environmental Considerations:

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA): The current proposal involves restrictions to parking. The proposal is not a “project” in accordance with Section 15378 of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines. The proposal does not have a potential for resulting in either direct or indirect physical changes in the environment. Therefore, as determined by the City’s Environmental Services Planning Manager, no environmental review is necessary.

Sustainability Considerations: This action supports the City of Sacramento’s sustainability goals to improve and optimize the transportation infrastructure.

Other: None.

Commission/Committee Action: None.

Rationale for Recommendation: Replacing the existing restrictions with “No Parking Any Time, Except with Permit,” will allow residents and their guests to park near their homes at all times.

In response to residents’ request, a parking occupancy study was conducted between January 25th and January 27th, 2011 during 6:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. It was determined that the number of occupied parking spaces (86%) was sufficient enough to adversely impact the residents. A letter outlining the proposed regulations and soliciting comments was sent to the residents who would be impacted by the changes. Of the 71 residents and property owners from the impacted area, 38 (54%) responded: 29 (76%) of the respondents voted in favor of the proposed changes and nine (24%) voted against.

Financial Considerations: The cost to implement the recommended parking regulation is estimated to be \$1,276.00. Funds are available in the Parking Services Division operating budget (Fund 1001).

Emerging Small Business Development (ESBD): Any goods or services will be purchased in accordance with established City policy.



Background Information

In 1980 the City Council adopted a resolution to implement the U.C. Davis Medical Center Residential Permit Parking Area (B), which is bounded by R Street, Y Street, 35th Street, and 51st Street, and to regulate with no parking from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., except with a permit.

During early morning and evening hours, non-residents, such as commuters, often park along U and V Streets making it difficult for residents and their guests to park near their homes.

MODIFY PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON PORTIONS OF U AND V STREETS

BACKGROUND

- A. Residents requested that parking restrictions on U and V Streets, from 45th Street to 48th Street, be changed from “No Parking 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Except with Permit” to “No Parking Any Time, Except with Permit.”
- B. In response to residents’ requests, a parking occupancy study was conducted between January 25th and January 27th, 2011 during 6:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. It was determined that the number of occupied parking spaces (86%) was sufficient enough to adversely impact the residents.
- C. A letter outlining the proposed regulations and soliciting comments was sent to residents who would be impacted by the changes. Of the 71 residents and property owners from the impacted area, 38 (76%) responded: 29 (76%) of the respondents voted in favor of the proposed changes and nine (24%) voted against.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The following streets are to be regulated with “No Parking Any Time, Except with Permit.”
- U Street, both sides, from 45th Street to 48th Street.
 - V Street, north side, from 45th Street to 48th Street.
- Section 2. Exhibit A is attached and is part of this Resolution.

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

Exhibit A - Map of Annexation Area
