APPLICATION FOR AND ACCEPTANCE OF FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2011 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG)

- A. The U.S Department of Justice, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program allows State and local governments to support a broad range of activities to prevent and control crime and to improve the criminal justice system. The JAG Program replaces the Byrne Formula and Local Law Enforcement Block Grant programs with a single funding mechanism. Forty percent of the JAG funding is designated for units of local government.
- B. As a designated eligible applicant, the Sacramento Police Department has applied for its Fiscal Year 2011 JAG allocation in the amount of \$422,032. The SPD is requesting approval to accept and use, if awarded, \$422,032 in federal funding for technical assistance and equipment in support of frontline officers' field operations, including air support.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The Interim City Manager, or the Interim City Manager's designee, is hereby authorized to accept, on behalf of the City of Sacramento, a \$422,032 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) from the U.S. Department of Justice, including any future agreements, modifications, amendments, or extensions thereof, if the City is awarded the grant.
- Section 2. The Interim City Manager, or the Interim City Manager's designee, is hereby authorized to establish a JAG project (#G11009100).
- Section 3. The Interim City Manager, or the Interim City Manager's designee, is hereby authorized to adjust the necessary revenue and expense budgets to implement the \$422,032 JAG project.


