AWARD CONTRACT FOR SOUTH LAND PARK WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT – PHASE 5 (Z14010052)

BACKGROUND

- A. The existing water distribution system in the South Land Park area identified as Phase 5 of the South Land Park Steel Water Main Replacement Project is deteriorated beyond rehabilitation. In order to improve reliability and health and safety, the City Council approved the South Land Park Steel Water Main Replacement Project, Phase 5 (Z14010052) budget in fiscal year 2010/2011.
- B. City staff prepared a set of plans and specifications to construct the Project, consisting of approximately 14,000 lineal feet of new water distribution mains complete with new water services, water meters, and fire hydrants.
- C. The project was advertised for bidding and bids were received on September 7th, 2011. United Building Contractors was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The contract plans and specifications for the South Land Park Water Main Replacement – Phase 5 (Z14010052) are approved, and the contract is awarded to United Building Contractors, for an amount not to exceed \$2,064,005.
