

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-558

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

AMERICAN RIVER CROSSINGS ALTERNATIVES STUDY

BACKGROUND

- A. Completion of the American River Crossings Alternatives Study will identify feasible crossing alternatives and provide the City of Sacramento with a strong basis for further regulatory steps required to satisfy the federal funding process.
- B. Bridges over rivers come with an expense that cannot typically be funded by local sources alone.
- C. In order to qualify for federal funding, a lengthy process beginning with the establishment of a clear purpose and need statement and an alternatives analysis must be undertaken.
- D. The tasks to be funded under this project will result in the requisite purpose and need statement and begins to narrow the field of potential crossing options.
- E. Caltrans awarded the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) the Partnership Planning Grant toward an American River Crossings Alternatives Study.
- F. The City of Sacramento is designated as a grant subrecipient for these funds.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The FY2011/12 Capital Improvement Program is amended by establishing a Capital Improvement Project (CIP) for the American River Crossings Alternatives Study (T15125300).
- Section 2. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute a subrecipient grant agreement with the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) and any other necessary agreements to execute the grant, when received from SACOG and/or Caltrans.
- Section 3. The City Manager is authorized to increase the American River Crossings Alternatives Study (T15125300) project's revenue and expenditure budgets by \$270,000 (Fund 3703).
- Section 4. Exhibit A is incorporated into and made part of this Resolution.
