

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2011-559**

### **ANNEXATION OF 63<sup>RD</sup> STREET INTO THE SUTTER HOSPITAL RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA (A)**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. Residents requested that both sides of 63rd Street, from Elvas Avenue to Folsom Boulevard, be annexed into the Sutter Hospital Residential Permit Parking Area (A) and regulated with "Two Hour Parking, Except with Permit."
- B. In response to residents' request, a parking occupancy study was conducted between June 7 and June 9, 2011, during 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. During the study, the 37 available parking spaces were occupied 78% of the time which has been determined to be sufficient enough to adversely impact the residents of that area.
- C. A letter outlining the proposed regulations and soliciting comments was sent to the residents who would be impacted by the changes. Of the 48 residents and owners in the impacted area, 25 (52%) responded: 23 (92%) of the respondents voted in favor of the annexation and two (8%) voted against.
- D. There is sufficient funding within the Parking Division's FY2011/12 operating budget to implement the recommended parking regulation.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The following street is annexed into the Sutter Hospital Residential Permit Parking Area (A) and parking will be regulated with "Two Hour Parking, Except with Permit."
- 63rd Street, both sides, from Elvas Avenue to Folsom Boulevard.
