

# RESOLUTION NO. 2011-601

## AGREEMENT: PANACEA COUNSELING SERVICES (CALGRIP- SACRAMENTO GANG INTERVENTION AND PREVENTION PROJECT)

### BACKGROUND

- A. On August 30, 2011, City Council Resolution #2011-508 approved the acceptance of \$369,309 in grant funding from the Governor's Office of Gang and Youth Policy to implement the Sacramento Gang Prevention and Intervention Project. The program will provide targeted intervention and prevention services for youth at risk for gang affiliation.
- B. Panacea Counseling Services, Inc., is the contracted provider of alcohol and drug counseling services, evidence-based programming, and the Attendance Intervention Management Program at the Sacramento City Unified School District (SCUSD). The CalGRIP Grant requires a leveraging of existing services within the SCUSD for this project.

### BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized on behalf of the City of Sacramento, to execute a professional services agreement with Panacea Counseling Services, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$100,000 for the purpose of providing support services to the CalGRIP Grant Project.


