

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-602

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

November 1, 2011

AWARD CONTRACT FOR TELECOMMUNICATION CABLING AND WIRING MAINTENANCE SERVICES

BACKGROUND

- A. City staff issued a Request for Qualification (RFQ) for telecommunications cabling and wiring maintenance services that was advertised on the City's web site in August 2011. A total of two responses were received and both met the City's minimum requirements as noted in the RFQ. The two vendors submitting responses were Integrity Data and Fiber (IDF) and 3D Datacom.
- B. From time to time specialty cabling projects require specialized equipment and staff resources the City does not have. Having two vendors on contract will help ensure the City's telecommunication requirements are met.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Integrity Data and Fiber is awarded a one-year contract, with four one-year renewal options, for telecommunication cabling and wiring maintenance services, for an annual amount not to exceed \$250,000 and a total amount not to exceed \$1,250,000 for the potential maximum five year term.
- Section 2. 3D Datacom is awarded a one-year contract, with four one-year renewal options, for telecommunication cabling and wiring maintenance services, for an annual amount not to exceed \$150,000 and a total amount not to exceed \$750,000 for the potential maximum five year term.
- Section 3. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute the contracts with Integrity Data and Fiber and 3D Datacom and exercise the renewal options for the annual not to exceed amounts specified above, provided that sufficient funds are available in the budget adopted for the applicable Fiscal Year(s).
