

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-618

AWARDING CONTRACT FOR FUEL SITE MAINTENANCE, REPAIR, AND TESTING SERVICES

BACKGROUND

- A. In support of City departments and core operations, the Department of General Services, Fleet Management Division, has an ongoing need to maintain, repair and test City fuel sites to maintain the continuity of fuel supply and meet regulatory compliance requirements.
- B. In September 2011, Procurement Services, in accordance with City Code Section 3.56, issued Invitation for Bid No. B12131061002 for the purchase of fuel site maintenance, repair, and testing services. Four responses were received. Kaiser Commercial Petroleum was determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Kaiser Commercial Petroleum is awarded a five-year contract for the purchase of fuel site maintenance, repair, and testing services in a total amount not to exceed \$850,000 for the five year period.
- Section 2. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to execute the agreement specified above (and attached as Exhibit A), provided that sufficient funds are available in the budget adopted for the applicable fiscal year(s).
- Section 3. Exhibit A is part of this resolution.


