NEIGHBORHOOD TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PROGRAM (S15071100): ALKALI FLAT PROJECT APPROVAL

BACKGROUND

- A. The Neighborhood Traffic Management Program (NTMP) was adopted by City Council in December 1995 and officially began in May 1996.
- B. The Alkali Flat NTMP Project began in March 2011. The project has followed the NTMP guidelines established by Council Resolution. Exhibit A identifies project boundaries.
- C. A traffic calming plan has been designed by residents serving on the Traffic Calming Committee and voted on by neighborhood residents with a 77.9% approval rate. Exhibit B (attached) is the ballot.
- D. In response to residents' comments during the balloting process, the back-in angled parking proposed for F Street between 10th Street and 11th Street has been removed from the plan.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Alkali Flat NTMP Project is approved.







Do you want traffic calming measures in your neighborhood?

This is your opportunity to vote on the proposed traffic calming plan for your neighborhood. You must vote either yes or no for all measures indicated on this ballot. This advisory vote will determine whether the traffic calming plan will be presented to Sacramento City Council.

Your Vote Counts!

The Traffic Calming Committee, comprised of individuals from your neighborhood, has developed this plan with assistance from Sacramento City staff. All residents and businesses within the project boundary will receive a ballot.

We must receive a minimum of 25% return on the balloting. If a simple majority of ballots returned vote yes, the traffic calming plan will be submitted to Sacramento City Council for review and approval.

What will it cost you?

The Neighborhood Traffic Management Program traffic calming plan implementation is funded through Measure A. There is no cost to residents or homeowners.

Proposed Traffic Calming Plan:

High-Visibility Crosswalks - Install on:

- C St at 11th - east leg
- D St at 11th - east leg
- F & 11th St - west leg

Standard Crosswalks - Install on unmarked legs to supplement existing crosswalks at:

- 8th St at D St
- 11th St at D St
- F & 8th St
- F & 10th St
- 10th St at D St
- E St & 8th St
- F & 9th St
- F & 11th St

Pedestrian Island - Install on E St, east side of 9th St

Pedestrian Safety Signs:

- Install "Turning Traffic Must Yield to Pedestrians" sign on the northwest corner of C St & 12th St
- Update/add "at" crosswalk/advanced crosswalk signs on:
 - D St at 10th St
 - E St at 9th St
 - G & 11th St
- Add "School" plaque to existing school related signs on D St, between 11th & 12th St

Directional Signs - Install:

- "No Access to 7th St" on:
 - D St, west of 8th St
 - E St, west side of 8th St
- Curve warning signs installed on separate pipes at E St & 7th St
- Larger directional signage to "7th St" on the north and south sides of E St at 9th St
- Directional sign to "7th St" on:
 - F St, west of 8th St
 - 9th St, north of G St

Yield Sign Removal on 11th & C St

Centerline and Botts Dots approaching and through the intersection of C St & 11th

Back-In Angled Parking on the north side of F St between 10th & 11th St
