Description/Analysis

Issue: Each year, unpaid volunteers and interns provide essential services to the City of Sacramento without compensation. In a desire to support and encourage the contributions these volunteers and interns make, the City would like to provide them parking passes at no cost. All parking passes issued under this program will be for use at Memorial Garage which has sufficient capacity to accommodate enrolled volunteers.

Policy Considerations: This recommendation is consistent with the City's strategic plan and the goals of the City Council to expand economic development throughout the City.

Environmental Considerations:

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA): The project is exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guideline 15301 as it is for the operation of an existing public structure with negligible or no expansion of use.

Rationale for Recommendation: Many volunteers and interns who provide essential services to the City of Sacramento do so with no compensation and at their own expense. To encourage future enrollment of volunteers and interns, the City desires to provide convenient parking at no cost.

BACKGROUND
