

RESOLUTION NO.2012-321

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

RIVERSIDE BOULEVARD AND PARK RIVIERA WAY TRAFFIC SIGNAL INSTALLATION (S15114300) - TRANSFER OF FUNDS, APPROVE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARD CONTRACT

BACKGROUND

- A. The goal of this project is to construct a new traffic signal at the intersection of Riverside Boulevard and Park Riviera Way to improve traffic operations and safety.
- B. The project was advertised and a total of two bids were received on July 11, 2012. M&M Electric is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.
- C. Contract award to M&M Electric. is recommended.
- D. The transfer of \$169,089 from the Major Street Improvement Project (T15138000) to the Riverside Boulevard and Park Riviera Way Traffic Signal Installation Project (S15114300) is needed to cover the higher than anticipated construction bid amount, additional inspection labor for Electrical and Civil work, and additional project management for real estate work.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The FY2012/13 Capital Improvement Program is amended by transferring \$169,089 (Fund 2007) from the Major Street Improvement Project (T15138000) to the Riverside Boulevard and Park Riviera Way Traffic Signal Installation Project (S15114300).
- Section 2. Plans and Specifications for the Riverside Boulevard and Park Riviera Way Traffic Signal Installation Project (S15114300) are approved.
- Section 3. A construction contract is awarded to M&M Electric in an amount not-to-exceed \$246,436.
- Section 4. Exhibit A is attached and is part of this Resolution.



