


MAYOR'S GANG PREVENTION TASK FORCE STRATEGIC PLAN

We value our youth.


We cannot arrest our way out of this problem.

COURSES OF ACTION TOWARDS SUCCESS



GOALS

1. SCHOOL BASED APPROACH

- Increase school based supports and enrichment activities to facilitate student achievement

2. COMMUNITY EMPOWERMENT

- Strengthen community capacity to address gang involvement and create safe neighborhoods

3. WORKFORCE READINESS

- Provide workforce readiness and other positive alternatives for at risk youth

4. REGIONAL ACCOUNTABILITY

- Develop regional collaboration towards enforcement, awareness and evaluation

YEAR 1 ACTION ITEMS

- 1. Implement the Gang Prevention and Literacy (GPAL) project in partnership with Boys and Girls Club, Way UP and Sac READS!**
- 2. Expand the Ceasefire strategy to all active gangs in the entire South Sacramento region via call-in sessions, street outreach and community engagement.**
- 3. Conduct certified violence reduction/conflict mediation training for 50 community stakeholders.**
- 4. Implement Violence Prevention Summit in conjunction with Street Soldiers National Consortium.**
- 5. Provide support for late night basketball and other athletic programs in high crime neighborhoods in partnership with Police and Sheriff athletic leagues.**
- 6. Secure staffing for the MGPTF and solidify structure of Policy Board and Technical Team.**
