

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-359

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

October 23, 2012

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT FOR ISSUANCE OF REVOCABLE PERMIT FOR THE SACRAMENTO CONVENTION CENTER

BACKGROUND

- A. WOMBO, Inc. has been operating telecommunications services at the Sacramento Convention Center since 2000, at which time the City entered into City Agreement No. 2000-0198. After the initial term of City Agreement No. 2000-0198 came to a close, by mutual agreement between WOMBO, Inc. and City, the term was extended for five additional one-year terms.
- B. At the end of the fifth extended one-year term of City Agreement No. 2000-0198, the City issued and a Request for Services (RFP). WOMBO was the only responding proposer and as such, WOMBO, Inc. and City entered into City Agreement No. 2010-1020.
- C. The City has a continuing need to provide telecommunications services at the Sacramento Convention Center and under City Code Section 3.76.050, any telecommunications providers who propose to locate telecommunications infrastructure on City-owned property must enter into an Agreement for Issuance of Revocable Permit

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager or City Manager's designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute the Agreement for Issuance of Revocable permit – Sacramento Convention Center with WOMBO, Inc.
- Section 2. The City Manager or City Manager's designee is hereby authorized to execute such other documents as necessary to implement the revocable permit agreement.
- Section 3. Exhibit A is a part of this Resolution.
