

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2012-368**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

October 30, 2012

### **ESTABLISHING PERMIT FEES FOR ADMINISTRATIVE PARKING PERMITS AND TEMPORARY SURFACE PARKING LOT PERMITS**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. Section 17.64.070 to the Sacramento City Code authorizes an administrative parking permit to approve alternatives to standard parking requirements and other modifications.
- B. Section 17.64.090 authorizes temporary surface parking lot permits within a high need parking area or within the downtown restricted parking area.
- C. The proposed fees for permits issued under Section 17.64.070 are set forth in Exhibit A
- D. The proposed fees for permits issued under Section 17.64.090 are set forth in Exhibit B.
- E. The amount of the proposed fees is no more than necessary to cover the City's reasonable costs to issue the permits and otherwise administer and enforce Sections 17.64.070 and 17.64.090. In addition, the manner in which those costs are allocated to the permittees bears a reasonable relationship to each permittee's burdens on, or benefits received from, the City.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The City of Sacramento Fee and Charge Report, Community Development Department, is hereby amended, as set forth in Exhibit A, to establish the amount of the fees authorized by Section 17.64.070 of the Sacramento City Code.
- Section 2. The City of Sacramento Fee and Charge Report, Community Development Department, is hereby amended, as set forth in Exhibit B, to establish the amount of the fees authorized by Section 17.64.090 of the Sacramento City Code.
- Section 2. Exhibits A and B are part of this resolution.



## Exhibit A

**Fee Name:** Administrative Parking Permit (Sacramento City Code Section 17.64.070)

**Current Fee:** None

**Proposed Fee:** \$2,000

**Justification:** The fees recover 100% of estimated costs for a permit process that includes review of the permit application by staff, permit administration, and site inspection, all at the department's hourly rate of \$140. It is estimated that staff time for an administrative parking permit would take 15 hours.

**Proposition 26:** These fees are not "taxes" under section 1, subdivision (e), in article XIII C of the California Constitution, as they are within the exception set out in subdivision (e)(3) of that section. The fees recoup not more than 100% of the Department's actual cost of issuing the permits and inspecting the sites. No fee waivers are provided, and the Department's costs are allocated equally to the persons who apply for permits and permit renewals.

## **Exhibit B**

**Fee Name:** Temporary Surface Parking Lot Permits (Sacramento City Code Section 17.64.090)

**Current Fee:** None

**Proposed Fees:** \$560

**Justification:** The fees recover 100% of estimated costs for a permit process that includes review of the permit application by staff, permit administration, and site inspection, all at the department's hourly rate of \$140. It is estimated that staff time for a temporary surface parking lot permit would take 4 hours.

**Proposition 26:** These fees are not "taxes" under section 1, subdivision (e), in article XIII C of the California Constitution, as they are within the exception set out in subdivision (e)(3) of that section. The fees recoup not more than 100% of the Department's actual cost of issuing the permits and inspecting the sites. No fee waivers are provided, and the Department's costs are allocated equally to the persons who apply for permits and permit renewals.
