

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-404

GRANT/AGREEMENT: CALIFORNIA TASK FORCE SEVEN ("CA TF-7"), URBAN SEARCH AND RESCUE ("US&R") TEAM HURRICANE ISAAC WHITE INCIDENT SUPPORT TEAM ("IST") DEPLOYMENT (G12702300)

BACKGROUND

- A. The City of Sacramento, Fire Department has been the sponsoring agency for CA TF-7 US&R team since the inception of the Federal Urban Search & Rescue program in the early 1990's. CA TF-7 has responded for emergency assistance to the bombing of the Federal Murrah building in Oklahoma City, the terrorist attack of the World Trade Center in New York, to the Gulf Coast in the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina and various other events.
- B. CA TF-7 can be deployed as an entire team, or individual Incident Support Team ("IST") members, to provide overhead support to man-made and natural disasters; and national special security events.
- C. On August 27, 2012, CA TF-7's White IST team representatives were activated by the Department of Homeland Security/Federal Emergency Management Agency ("DHS/FEMA") for deployment to Hurricane Isaac.
- D. To receive reimbursement for costs associated with the deployment activities for the Hurricane Isaac White IST deployment, the City must adopt a resolution granting signature authority for the City Manager to sign the DHS/FEMA Assistance Award/Amendment EMW-2008-CA-1498, Amendment M015.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager, or Fire Chief and Deputy Fire Chief, as his designees, is authorized to execute the agreement (EMW-2008-CA-1498, Amendment M015) (attached as Exhibit A) to accept the federal funding for CA TF-7 US&R Team in the amount of \$30,800.
- Section 2. An operating grant shall be established for the CA TF-7 US&R Hurricane Isaac White IST Deployment (G12702300).
- Section 3. A revenue and expenditure budget in the amount of \$30,800 shall be established for the CA TF-7 US&R Hurricane Isaac White IST Deployment (G12702300).
- Section 4. Exhibit A is a part of this Resolution.




