

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-0004

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

January 3, 2013

PROPOSED TWO HOUR PARKING RESTRICTIONS FOR A SECTION OF 2ND STREET

BACKGROUND

- A. Parking on the west side of 2nd Street, between O and P Streets, is currently unregulated and often occupied by vehicles for extended periods of time. Regulating parking on the west side of 2nd Street with "Two-Hour Parking, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Excluding Sundays" will allow customers to park near Crocker Art Museum.
- B. In response to Crocker Art Museum's request, a parking occupancy study was conducted between October 16 and October 18, 2012, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. It was determined that the average parking occupancy (61%) was sufficient enough to adversely impact the business.
- C. A vote was not conducted for this request as there is only one property owner.
- D. There is sufficient funding within the Parking Services Division's FY2012/13 General Fund operating budget to implement the recommended parking regulation.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The following street will be regulated with "Two Hour Parking, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Excluding Sundays":
- 2nd Street, west side, between O and P Streets.


