

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-0067

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

March 5, 2013

BACKGROUND

- A. On October 6, 2009, City Council approved Resolution #2009-623, authorizing Agreement #2009-874 for the provision of School Resource Officers at NUSD campuses. That agreement expired June 4, 2010 and was not renewed by NUSD.
- B. A new agreement has been negotiated with NUSD for the term beginning March 1, 2013 and ending June 30, 2014. The salary, benefits, and vehicle costs associated with the agreement will be fully funded by the NUSD.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is hereby authorized to execute an agreement between the Sacramento Police Department (SPD) and the Natomas Unified School District (NUSD) for the provision of safety services beginning March 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2014 for a total amount not to exceed \$347,895.
- Section 2. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is hereby authorized to increase the SPD staffing level by two (2.00) full-time equivalent Police Officer positions for the provision of safety services at NUSD campuses.
- Section 3. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is hereby authorized to increase the SPD's operating revenue and expense budgets by an amount not to exceed \$347,895.


