

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-0114

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

APPROVAL OF MEMORANDA OF UNDERSTANDING FOR STATIONARY ENGINEERS, LOCAL 39 REPRESENTING OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE, PLANT OPERATOR, GENERAL SUPERVISORY, OFFICE AND TECHNICAL, AND PROFESSIONAL UNITS

BACKGROUND

- A. The 2010-2012 labor agreements between the City of Sacramento and Stationary Engineers, Local 39 (Local 39) expired on June 29, 2012.
- B. In June 2012, the City completed bargaining with Local 39, which represents employees in the Operations and Maintenance Unit (Representation Unit 03), Plant Operator Unit (Representation Unit 04), General Supervisory Unit (Representation Unit 15), Office and Technical Unit (Representation Unit 16), and Professional Unit (Representation Unit 17).
- C. The negotiations resulted in three Letters of Understanding (LOUs), which contained a provision that the City would produce final Memoranda of Understanding (MOUs).
- D. The terms of the LOUs have been incorporated into three MOUs consistent with the terms approved by the City Council, along with the standard cleanup of outdated contract language.
- E. The adoption of these MOUs will complete the City's legal obligations under the Myers-Milias Brown Act.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The final Memorandum of Understanding covering employees in the Operations and Maintenance, Office and Technical, and Professional Units is approved.
- Section 2. The final Memorandum of Understanding covering employees in the Plant Operators Unit is approved.
- Section 3. The final Memorandum of Understanding covering employees in the General Supervisory Unit is approved.


