**Title: Parking Restrictions on Edgewater Road and Railroad Drive**

**Location:** Both sides of Edgewater Road, from Arden Way to Lochbrae Road, District 2, and both sides of Railroad Drive, north of Del Paso Boulevard, District 3

**Issue:** The Sacramento Police Department has received multiple complaints from neighboring residents and business owners regarding criminal activity at night and has requested that parking on the selected streets be restricted with "No Parking from 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m." to help deter criminal activity.

**Recommendation:** Pass a Resolution restricting parking on both sides of Edgewater Road, from Arden Way to Lochbrae Road and both sides of Railroad Drive, north of Del Paso Boulevard with "No Parking 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m."

## Description/Analysis

**Issue Detail:** Parking on the proposed sections of Edgewater Road and Railroad Drive is currently unregulated. The Sacramento Police Department has received multiple complaints from the residents and businesses on those streets regarding criminal activity at night and has requested that parking be restricted with “No Parking from 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.” to help reduce crime in those areas.

**Policy Considerations:** This recommendation supports the Central City Parking Master Plan goal to make parking safe, secure, attractive and convenient.

### **Environmental Considerations:**

**California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA):** The current proposal involves restrictions to parking. The proposal is not a “project” in accordance with Section 15378 of the CEQA Guidelines. The implementation of these parking restrictions does not have a potential for resulting in either direct or indirect physical changes in the environment. Therefore, as determined by the City’s Environmental Services Planning Manager, no environmental review is necessary.

**Sustainability Considerations:** This action supports the City of Sacramento’s sustainability goals to improve and optimize the transportation infrastructure.

**Other:** None.

**Commission/Committee Action:** None.

**Rationale for Recommendation:** The residents and businesses along the proposed sections of Edgewater Road and Railroad Drive have submitted numerous complaints to the Sacramento Police Department about ongoing criminal activity at night. In response to the residents and business owner’s requests, the Police Department is recommending that parking along the proposed streets be restricted with “No Parking from 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.” to help reduce crime in those areas.

**Financial Considerations:** The cost to implement the recommended parking regulation is estimated to be \$3,600. Sufficient funds are available in the Parking Services Division operating budget (Fund 1001).

**Local Business Enterprise Program (LBE):** Any goods or services will be purchased in accordance with established City policy.

### **PARKING RESTRICTION FOR EDGEWATER ROAD AND RAILROAD DRIVE FROM 9:00 P.M. TO 6:00 A.M.**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. Parking on the proposed sections of Edgewater Road and Railroad Drive is currently unregulated. The Sacramento Police Department has received multiple complaints from the residents and businesses on those streets regarding criminal activity at night and has requested that parking be restricted with "No Parking from 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m." to help reduce crime in those areas.
- B. There is sufficient funding within the Parking Division's Fiscal Year 2013/14 operating budget to implement the recommended parking regulation.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The following streets will be regulated with "No Parking, 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m."
- Edgewater Road, both sides, from Arden Way to Lochbrae Road
  - Railroad Drive, both sides, north of Del Paso Blvd.


