## Description/Analysis

**Issue Detail:** Designation of a voting delegate is required in order to vote at the business meeting at the 2014 League of California Cities Annual Conference. Only members who have been chosen by the majority vote of their City Council may vote.

**Policy Considerations:** This action complies with the League of California Cities requirement that voting delegates be selected by City Council action.

**Rationale for Recommendation:** Each City Council must designate a voting delegate in order to vote at the business meeting at the 2014 League of California Cities Annual Conference. Shirey as the voting delegate, and City Treasurer Russell Fehr as the alternate voting delegate, as is allowable by the League of California Cities bylaws.

At the business meeting on Friday, September 5, the League membership will consider and take action on resolutions that establish League policy. In order to vote at the Annual Business Meeting each City Council must designate a voting delegate and may, if they wish, designate up to two alternate voting delegates.
