Description/Analysis

Issue: The east side of 8th Street, between Victorian Alley and V Street, the south side of V Street between 8th and 9th Streets, and the west side of 9th Street between Victorian Alley and V Street, are immediately adjacent to Met High School and currently regulated with two-hour parking which does not meet the requirements of students attending the school. Other neighboring streets are unregulated and often occupied throughout the day by non-students. Extending the current regulations on the proposed sections from “2 Hour Parking 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Excluding Saturdays and Sundays” to “4 Hour Parking 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Excluding Saturdays and Sundays” will provide more parking that meets the needs of Met High School students.

Policy Considerations: This recommendation supports the Central City Parking Master Plan goal to make parking safe, secure, attractive, and convenient.

Environmental Considerations:

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA): The current proposal involves restrictions to parking. The proposal is not a “project” in accordance with Section 15378 of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines. The proposal does not have a potential for resulting in either direct or indirect physical changes in the environment. Therefore, as determined by the City’s Environmental Services Planning Manager, no environmental review is necessary.

Sustainability Considerations: This action supports the City of Sacramento’s sustainability goals to improve and optimize the transportation infrastructure.

Other: None.

Commission/Committee Action: None.

Rationale for Recommendation: Currently, the east side of 8th Street, between Victorian Alley and V Street, the south side of V Street between 8th and 9th Streets, and the west side of 9th Street between Victorian Alley and V Street is regulated with two-hour parking which is not enough time to meet the academic schedules of students attending Met High School. Extending the current regulations on the proposed sections from “2 Hour Parking 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Excluding Saturdays and Sundays” to “4 Hour Parking 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Excluding Saturdays and Sundays” will provide short-term parking that better serves the needs of Met High School students.

In response to school administrators’ request, a parking occupancy study was conducted between September 16 and September 18, during 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. It was determined the average parking occupancy (32%) was low enough to move forward with the proposed four-hour parking restriction.

Financial Considerations: The cost to implement the recommended parking regulation is estimated to be \$555. There are sufficient funds (Fund 1001) in the Parking Services Division operating budget.

FOUR HOUR PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON SECTIONS OF 8TH, 9TH & V STREETS

BACKGROUND

- A. Currently, the east side of 8th Street, between Victorian Alley and V Street, the south side of V Street between 8th and 9th Streets, and the west side of 9th Street between Victorian Alley and V Street is regulated with two-hour parking which is not enough time to meet the academic schedules of students attending Met High School. Extending the current time limits on the proposed street sections to four-hour parking will provide short-term parking that better serves the needs of Met High School students.
- B. In response to school administrators' request, a parking occupancy study was conducted between September 16 and September 18, during 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. It was determined the average parking occupancy (32%) was low enough to move forward with the proposed four-hour parking restriction.
- C. There is sufficient funding within the Parking Services Division's FY2014/15 operating budget to implement the recommended parking regulation.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The following streets will be regulated with "4 Hour Parking, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Excluding Saturdays and Sundays":
- 8th Street, east side, between Victorian Alley and V Street
 - 9th Street, west side, between Victorian Alley and V Street
 - V Street, south side, between 8th and 9th Streets
