Description/Analysis

Issue Detail: Parking on the south side of P Street, from the west property line of 1908 P Street to 20th Street is currently unregulated. Since it is unregulated, vehicles park in those spaces for extended periods of time making it difficult for customers of nearby businesses to park.

Policy Considerations: This recommendation supports the Central City Parking Master Plan goal to make parking safe, secure, attractive and convenient.

Environmental Considerations:

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA): The current proposal involves restrictions to parking. The proposal is not a “project” in accordance with Section 15378 of the CEQA Guidelines. The proposal does not have a potential for resulting in either direct or indirect physical changes in the environment. Therefore, as determined by the City’s Environmental Services Planning Manager, no environmental review is necessary.

Sustainability Considerations: This action supports the City of Sacramento’s sustainability goals to improve and optimize the transportation infrastructure.

Other: None.

Commission/Committee Action: None.

Rationale for Recommendation: Parking on the proposed section of P Street is currently unregulated so vehicles park in those spaces for extended periods of time. Regulating parking with “90 Minute Parking, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Excluding Sundays” will allow customers of nearby businesses to find parking.

A vote was not conducted for this request as there is only one property owner.

Financial Considerations: The cost to implement the recommended parking regulation is estimated to be \$500. Sufficient funds are available in the Parking Services Division operating budget (Fund 1001).


BACKGROUND
