## Description/Analysis

**Issue:** The California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) has awarded \$99,320 in grant funding to the Sacramento Police Department (SPD) to enforce alcohol-related laws and to prevent alcohol-related problems, such as underage drinking and over-serving.

**Policy Considerations:** The recommendations contained in this report are consistent with Resolution 2015-0169, Paragraph 11.3, which requires City Council approval if such action is required by the grantor.

**Economic Impact:** Not applicable.

**Environmental Considerations:** Not applicable.

**California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA):** The recommendations contained in this report do not constitute a “project” as defined by Section 21065 of the California Public Resources Code and therefore are not subject to the requirements of the CEQA.

**Sustainability Considerations:** Not applicable.

**Commission/Committee Action:** Not applicable.

**Rationale for Recommendation:** The City of Sacramento has more than 1,000 ABC-licensed establishments, with an average of 25 establishments per square mile within the downtown core. Alcohol-related problems, such as underage drinking and over serving, are of significant concern within this high-density area due to the number of people attracted to the area’s entertainment venues. ABC’s funding will allow the SPD to be proactive in the prevention of alcohol-related incidents by providing compliance education to ABC-licensed establishments.

**Financial Considerations:** The FY 2016/17 grant award of \$99,320 will partially support the costs of one police officer, to include overtime as well as operational costs such as confidential funds, equipment, and travel/training. The grantor limits reimbursement of benefit expenses to 30 percent of regular-time salary costs. Benefit expenses in excess of the 30 percent cap will be funded by the Operating Budget.

**FISCAL YEAR 2016/17 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL GRANT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM**

**BACKGROUND**

- A. The California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) has awarded the Sacramento Police Department (SPD) a \$99,320 grant award to enforce and prevent alcohol-related problems. The grant award will partially support the personnel costs of one full-time equivalent police officer, including overtime, and travel/training, equipment, and confidential operations funds.

Alcohol-related problems, such as underage drinking and over serving, are of significant concern within this high-density area due to the number of people attracted to the area's entertainment venues. **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to accept a grant award of \$99,320 from the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC);
  
- Section 2. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to establish an operating grant project (G11014800);
  
- Section 3. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to adjust and appropriate the necessary grant revenue and expense budgets for the award amount of \$99,320; and
  
- Section 4. The City Manager, or the City Manger's designee, is authorized to maintain the Full Time Equivalent (FTE) police officer position previously authorized by Resolution 2010-369.
