## Description/Analysis

**Issue:** The Language Academy of Sacramento, located at 2850 49<sup>th</sup> Street, has an estimated 200-250 cars dropping off and picking up students in the mornings and afternoons. Currently, there is a two-hour parking restriction zone directly in front of the school which accommodates roughly 12 vehicles. All other on-street parking spaces in the vicinity are unrestricted and often occupied by visitors and employees of nearby employment centers. Language Academy of Sacramento has requested regulating 11-13 parking spaces just north of the school (see Exhibit A) with two-hour parking to promote parking turnover during morning and afternoon drop-off and pick-up.

**Policy Considerations:** This recommendation supports the Central City Parking Master Plan goal to make parking safe, secure, attractive, and convenient.

**Economic Impacts:** None

### Environmental Considerations:

**California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA):** The current proposal involves restrictions to parking. The proposal is not a “project” in accordance with Section 15378 of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines. The proposal does not have a potential for resulting in either direct or indirect physical changes in the environment. Therefore, as determined by the City’s Environmental Services Planning Manager, no environmental review is necessary.

**Sustainability Considerations:** This action supports the City of Sacramento’s sustainability goals to improve and optimize the transportation infrastructure.

**Other:** None.

**Commission/Committee Action:** None.

**Rationale for Recommendation:** Much of the parking on 49<sup>th</sup> Street, north of Broadway and south of 2nd Avenue, is currently unregulated and often occupied by vehicles for extended periods of time. Regulating parking on 49<sup>th</sup> Street with “2 Hour Parking, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Excluding Saturdays and Sundays” will provide short-term parking for parents dropping off or picking up children at the Language Academy of Sacramento.

**Financial Considerations:** The cost to implement the recommended parking regulation is estimated to be \$650. There are sufficient funds (Fund 1001) in the Parking Services Division operating budget.

### **PROPOSED TWO-HOUR PARKING RESTRICTION ON A SECTION OF 49<sup>TH</sup> STREET**


#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. Except for a small section in front of the Language Academy of Sacramento, parking on 49<sup>th</sup> Street from Broadway to 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue is currently unregulated and occupied by vehicles for extended periods of time.
- B. Language Academy of Sacramento is requesting access to additional parking spaces just north of the school along 49<sup>th</sup> Street be restricted with “2 Hour Parking, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Excluding Saturdays and Sundays” to provide additional short-term parking for parents dropping off and picking up children.
- C. There is sufficient funding within the Parking Services Division’s FY2015/16 operating budget to implement the recommended parking regulation.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The following street will be regulated with “2 Hour Parking, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Excluding Saturdays and Sundays”
- North side of 49th Street from 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to 410 feet south of 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue
