Description/Analysis

Issue Detail: Parking on the proposed section of 10th Street (see Exhibit A) is currently unregulated and often occupied by vehicles for long periods of time, making it difficult for customers of neighboring businesses to find available parking nearby.

Policy Considerations: This recommendation supports the Central City Parking Master Plan goal to make parking safe, secure, attractive and convenient.

Economic Impacts: None

Environmental Considerations:

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA): The current proposal involves restrictions to parking. The proposal is not a “project” in accordance with Section 15378 of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines. The implementation of these parking restrictions does not have a potential for resulting in either direct or indirect physical changes in the environment. Therefore, as determined by the City’s Environmental Services Planning Manager, no environmental review is necessary.

Sustainability Considerations: This action supports the City of Sacramento’s sustainability goals to improve and optimize the transportation infrastructure.

Commission/Committee Action: None.

Rationale for Recommendation: Parking on the proposed section of 10th Street is currently unregulated and often occupied by vehicles for long periods of time, making it difficult for customers of neighboring businesses to find parking nearby. Regulating the parking with two hour restrictions will improve vehicle turnover and provide access to local businesses. A vote was conducted for this request and two out of the three property owners responded with both voting in favor of the proposed changes.

Financial Considerations: The cost to implement the recommended parking regulation is estimated to be \$250. Sufficient funds are available in the Parking Services Division operating budget (Fund 1001).

BACKGROUND


- A. Parking on the proposed section of 10th Street (see Exhibit A) is currently unregulated and often occupied by vehicles for long periods of time, making it difficult for customers of neighboring businesses to find available parking nearby. Regulating the parking with two-hour restrictions will help with vehicle turnover and provide parking for customers. A vote was conducted for this request and two out of the three property owners voted in favor of the proposed changes.
- B. A letter outlining the proposed regulations and soliciting comments was sent to the property owners that would be impacted by the changes. A vote was conducted for this request and two out of the three property owners responded with both voting in favor of the proposed changes.
- C. There is sufficient funding within the Parking Services Division's FY2015/16 operating budget to implement the recommended parking regulation.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The following street will be regulated with "2 Hour Parking, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Excluding Saturdays and Sundays"
- 10th Street, east side, between the Victorian Alley and W Street
