Description/Analysis

Issue Detail: The California State Department of Parks and Recreation (CA DPR) is currently accepting applications for its FY2017/18 California Youth Soccer and Recreation Development grant program. CA DPR administers the California Youth Soccer and Recreation Development Program that awards grants on a competitive basis for “fostering the development of new youth soccer, baseball, softball, and basketball recreation opportunities...(in) heavily populated, low-income urban areas with a high youth crime and unemployment rate”. The City Department of Parks and Recreation is seeking authority to apply for this grant to fund improvements to McClatchy Park, including ballfield renovations, referred to as the McClatchy Park Ballfield Improvements project.

Policy Considerations: The recommendations in this report are consistent with the City’s approved strategic plan to enhance livability in Sacramento’s neighborhoods by expanding park, recreation, and trail facilities throughout the City. This action is also part of the Park Development Process for park planning as stated in the 2005-2010 Parks and Recreation Master Plan.

Economic Impacts: None.

Environmental Considerations: The proposed action is exempt from environmental review as a government fiscal activity under CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(4).

Sustainability: The proposed application is consistent with the goals, policies and targets of the *City’s Sustainability Master Plan* and the *Parks and Recreation Sustainability Plan*.

Commission/Committee Action: None.

Rationale for Recommendation: The McClatchy Park Ballfields Improvement project meets all of the CA DPR grant criteria because it:

- 1) is located in an economically disadvantaged area; and
- 2) is “grant ready” with approved master plan, defined scope, and matching funds are available.

Financial Considerations: With Council approval, the grant application for up to \$800,000 will be submitted to the California State Department of Parks and Recreation. Matching funds of up to \$200,000 in Quimby Funds (Fund 2508) are

available in this project's planning area. If the grant is awarded, staff will return to Council for approval to accept the grant, approve the grant agreement, and establish a capital improvement project.

AUTHORIZATION TO SUBMIT APPLICATION FOR THE
FY2017/18 CALIFORNIA YOUTH SOCCER AND RECREATION
DEVELOPMENT GRANT PROGRAM

BACKGROUND

- A. The California State Department of Parks and Recreation administers the California Youth Soccer and Recreation Development Program. The Department awards grants on a competitive basis for "fostering the development of new youth soccer, baseball, softball, and basketball recreation opportunities...(in) heavily populated, low-income urban areas with a high youth crime and unemployment rate".
- B. Improvements to McClatchy Park, including ballfield renovations, for up to \$800,000 would be an eligible project under this grant program. Matching funds of up to \$200,000 from Quimby funds (Fund 2508) are available in the planning area for this project.
- C. A City Council resolution, as well as a Grantor resolution, are required to be submitted with grant proposal.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to submit an application for the FY2017/18 California Youth Soccer and Recreation Development Program Grant Program for renovation of McClatchy Park in the amount of \$800,000.

3. Certifies that the Applicant has reviewed, understands, and agrees to the General Provisions contained in the contract shown in the Grant Administration Guide; and
4. Delegates the authority to the Director of the Parks and Recreation Department to conduct all negotiations, sign and submit all documents, including, but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, and payment requests, which may be necessary for the completion of the Grant Scope; and
5. Agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations and guidelines.
