Background: The Maddy Act (Government Code section 54972) requires that on or before December 31 of each year, a list be prepared showing which city appointed board, commission, and committee positions expire in the next calendar year. This list (Attachment 2) must include which terms will expire, the name of the incumbent, the date of appointment, the date of term expiration, and the necessary qualifications for the position. This list is being prepared early to allow maximum time for successful recruitment.

As noted in the Maddy Act, this information is made available to tap into the talent that exists among the citizenry, who are too frequently not aware of the opportunities for participation on local advisory boards, commissions, and committees.
