Message	Friends, The City of Sacramento is in financial crisis. Everything we can do to help ease this situation will aid taxpayers of our city. Currently, the city holds two elections to elect members of the city council. If we used the single transferable vote method of proportional representation, also known as choice voting, we could elect the entire city council in November every four years. City ballot initiatives could be placed on the ballot at that time. If each election costs around \$180,000, we could save the city over half a million dollars (about \$540,000) by having one election instead of four. I will return to the states in mid-June and hope to see you then. C. T. Weber
