BACKGROUND

The Sacramento Charter Review Committee transmitted its Final Report to the City Council on November 3, 2009. Pursuant to Resolution R2009-559, the Committee is responsible for issuing two supplemental reports. The following represents Supplemental Report No. 1.

1. FINAL RECOMMENDATIONS: Full-Time Mayor/Full-Time City Council

The Committee's governing resolution requires final recommendations to be approved by an affirmative vote of at least seven Committee members. Members who do not approve a recommendation are authorized to prepare a minority report.

The Committee met on November 5, 2009 to vote on tentative decisions related to the outside compensation of the Mayor and Full-time vs. Part-Time Mayor and City Council Members. The Committee subsequently met on November 16, 2009 to vote on final decisions on these issues. The following recommendations include a summary of the Committee's vote and a section reserved for an explanation of the vote. A minority report follows this section.

Responsibilities and Outside Income of the Mayor

Final Recommendation: Responsibilities of the Mayor should continue to be identified as full-time, and outside income of the Mayor should not be limited (to take effect in 2012).
