To Whom It May Concern:

As a 10 year homeowner in the Land Park community of the City of Sacramento, I have enjoyed dependable utility service at my home at reasonable rates. However, as a Civil Engineer, I am well aware of the City's aging infrastructure and the challenge of maintaining dependable service at affordable rates. If establishing utility rates were a simple manner, then the City Council would not have establish the Utility Rate Advisory Commission to assist them with approving appropriate rates that are affordable to residents and businesses while providing the needed capital to improve and maintain our City's aging infrastructure and keep up with inflationary pressures on labor and materials.

As a program manager for large irrigation and hydroelectric projects, I understand how today's services are financed by tomorrow's dollars. I also understand the inherent risks associated with long-term financing as well as the measures that can be taken to minimize these risks. I believe that I can translate this knowledge and apply it to discerning risks for the City of Sacramento Utilities Department.

I do not presume, nor would I present to you, that I completely understand the details of the Department of Utilities' budgeting policies and other soft costs that impact the direct application of utility rates towards O&M activities and capital improvements. However, given my background in managing staff and corporate overhead budgets, I believe I would be a quick learn.

In terms of out-of-the-box approach, I would like to see the following options investigated. If they haven't already been evaluated and deemed impractical, I look forward to reviewing the studies:

- Establish separate rate structures for day-to-day operations & maintenance versus capital improvements, to prevent the cost of today's work from stealing from future infrastructure projects.
- Develop benefit-targeted rate structures, similar to SAFCA's consolidated capital assessment, to insure that residents pay for improvements that benefit their neighborhood.

I appreciate your consideration for this opportunity look forward to any future discussions and evaluations of my ability to serve our great City in this capacity.

Key Qualifications

Scott Brown is a registered civil engineer in California with 12 years of experience in water resources engineering. He has been involved in and managed the planning, design, permitting and implementation of comprehensive flood control, irrigation, and hydroelectric projects. His project experience includes storm drains, levees, floodwalls, pump stations, diversion facilities, fish screens, and fish ladders. He has prepared improvements for open channel and piped irrigation and drainage facilities for crop specific water demands. He has designed concrete, masonry, steel and wood structures, including pump sumps, floodwalls, retaining walls, rock bin walls and control buildings. Scott has also assisted in FERC dam safety inspections with experience in site inspections, monitoring equipment, and stress and stability analyses.

Experience

Scott's project experience includes:

- Wastewater Treatment Plant Headworks Improvements 2007, Corcoran, CA: project engineer for the development and design of a new Headworks facility for WWTP to increase the intake capacity of the plant from approximately 2.0 MGD to 5.3 MGD. The new Headworks is equipped with a ¼-inch open space bar screen and rake, extending nearly 20 feet from the invert of the intake channel to ground level for easy handling of screening material. The screening material is processed through a washer, grinder and compactor then bagged within a debris bin for disposal. The new subsurface structure is located adjacent to the existing headworks and tied together at the wet well through a 3-ft by 3-ft hole cut through the existing wet well wall.
- Strategic Alliance Contract for Civil Design – Pacific Gas & Electric Hydro Division, Central & Southern Regions, CA: project manager and engineer for multiple civil improvement projects throughout the central and southern hydro regions. Work was coordinated with the electrical and mechanical design consultants on the project team. Projects included penstock saddle replacement, trash rack installation, vibration study, new stream flow measuring weirs, platform and stairway improvements, crew housing infrastructure and other miscellaneous projects. He was responsible for carrying each project through the following phases:
 - Pre-scope: identify the necessary information required to develop the scope of the project
 - Scope: develop the engineering scope of work required to complete the project
 - Conceptual design: perform all investigations, surveys and research in order to prepare a design basis report and a conceptual plan for the project. Required for approval to proceed


- 50% design: advance design to provide sufficient design and drawing details to prepare construction budget. Identify any long-lead items and prepare stand alone specifications for procurement. Approval required and design scope frozen
- 100% design and issue-for-construction drawings: complete design drawings, specifications and cost estimate for construction by PG&E crews or for bidding to general contractor. Documents prepared to PG&E drawing standards and specification format
- Construction support: respond to field questions, RFIs, fabrication shop drawings and submittals as requested by PG&E staff.

In tandem with the project design, he was responsible for preparing work summaries and reporting to PG&E at monthly progress meetings. Additional support for PG&E staff and crews was provided on a project-need basis to insure proper execution of the work from scoping, to agency design approvals, and through implementation.

- Diversion Dam and Intake Facility Design, El Dorado County, CA: design engineer for the rehabilitation of an existing diversion dam and design of a new intake facility with fish screens and fish ladder. The new bin wall dam diverts up to 170 cfs from the south fork of the American River through a diversion structure into 23 miles of canal to a 17 megawatt hydroelectric power plant. The diversion structure consisted of state-of-the-art fish screens, cleaning system and controls; and a 40 cfs weir and pool fish ladder. Scott provided on-site services and design review during construction of the facilities. He also prepared the design of modifications to the fish ladder to meet fish passage requirements for modified operational levels and post-construction grading downstream of the ladder.
- White Mallard Dam and Five Points Diversion, Butte Sink and Butte Creek, CA: design engineer for the reconstruction of a removable irrigation diversion dam and fish ladder in Butte Creek. The diversion dam consisted of a sheet pile and concrete structure equipped with removable bulks for winter flood flows. The fish ladder was a weir and pool ladder capable of passing 20 to 40 cfs with varying upstream operating water levels controlled by the dam and two diversions. He performed hydraulic analysis for the entire system to meet irrigation demands while maintaining minimum fish flows down Butte Creek.
- American Basin Fish Screen and Habitat Improvement, Sacramento and Sutter Counties, CA: project engineer during feasibility and preliminary design to provide fish screens for five diversions on the Sacramento River, with a combined capacity of 630 cfs. He developed eight alternatives with a hydraulic analysis and conceptual design for each; prepared economical analysis for each alternative, including initial capital costs, operation and maintenance costs, and annual replacement allowances; and prepared preliminary design and cost estimates for preferred alternative. He was also project engineer during the final design of the irrigation facility improvements required for the consolidation of the diversions. Those improvements included approximately 2.5 miles of new irrigation delivery canal, two miles of new field drainage canal, and modifications to approximately two miles of existing irrigation delivery. The irrigation improvements also included the additional pumping capacity at existing lift facilities and the reconstruction of a check and lift pump structure to manage supply and demand of re-circulated drainage water. The construction cost associated with the irrigation facility improvements is estimated at \$10 million, with the total consolidation project estimated at \$32.5 million. He assisted with environment documentation obtaining project acceptance from regulatory and funding agencies; supplied updated design and cost information for US Bureau of Reclamation Value Engineering Study; and prepared all reports and documentation required to obtain funding grants and reimbursement of project expenses for the client.

- Various Flood Control Improvement Projects, Sacramento Area Flood Control Agency, Sutter County, CA: design engineer on multiple small local flood improvement projects. His involvement varied from a supporting design role to design lead. Construction projects required review of project staking, approval of contractor submittals, responding to RFIs and assisting county inspectors with field instructions, pay estimates, and change orders. He was involved in the following SAFCA projects:
 - Natomas Levee Evaluation Program – agency engineer with local infrastructure knowledge
 - Sacramento River east bank setback levee feasibility
 - Alternative analysis for incorporating flood control features into Natomas Mutual Water Company's fish screen project
 - Arcade Creek levee and floodwall
 - Exhibit preparation for expert witness testimony – Dry Creek floodplain.
 - Magpie Creek diversion
 - Magpie Creek channel enhancements
 - Garden Highway stability berm
- Emergency Levee Repairs, Sacramento, CA: design engineer responsible for directing staff in the design and preparation of construction plans and specifications for emergency repairs to six hundred feet of levee north of the Sacramento International Airport. Scott also performed design reviews, prepared cost estimates and maintained project schedule. Initial plans were to remove an abandoned low culvert levee crossing and construct a 110-foot deep levee cutoff wall. The project was bid as two separate construction contracts. Due to budget and time constraints, the project plans were reworked to install a one hundred foot long, sixty foot deep sheet pile wall prior to flood season.
- Flood Control Improvement Project, St. Helena, CA: design engineer for project to provide 100-year flood protection to residents in the Vineyard Valley Mobile Home Park located adjacent to the Napa River. The project includes approximately 2,000 feet of floodwall along the river bank and approximately 2,500 feet of levee to prevent outflanking. Interior flooding is eliminated by routing new 48-inch storm drain to a detention basin sized to handle the runoff volume and a pump station capable of pumping the runoff through the levee during the 100-year event. The project required removal of several mobile homes and acquisition of right-of-way for construction of the floodwall. He provided recommendations for detention basin and pump sizing, and was responsible for oversight and quality review of hydrology, storm drain improvements, structural design of the floodwall and pump sump, and coordination for environmental, geotechnical and streambed restoration sub-consultants.
- Natomas Basin Comprehensive Drainage Plan, Sacramento County, CA: design engineer for project to provide 100-year flood protection for hundreds of acres in the south end of the Natomas basin that was annexed by the city of Sacramento. In a joint project with the Reclamation District 1000 and Sacramento, miles of levees were constructed along RD1000 drainage canals and pumping capacity was added to three of the district's largest pumps stations. Scott supported the civil design during construction of the levees. He provided the civil and structural design effort required to completely reconstruct Pumping Plant No. 3 and construct an expansion intake bay on Pumping Plant No. 8. He also provided engineering support during the construction of these two pump stations.
- Mokelumne River Hydroelectric Project, Amador County, CA: civil engineer responsible for the civil/structural engineering and design of three PG&E sites on the north fork of the Mokelumne River. The three sites required modification of existing facilities to provide a wide range of release flows to comply with requirements for FERC relicensing. The project included alternative analysis to final design of two new outfall structures, one housing a 24- and a 72-in fixed cone valve and the other housing an 18- and a 60-in fixed cone valve. The third site required modifications to an abandon by-pass flume and construction of a new outfall structure for a 48-inch sluice gate.

- Cascade Dam Spillway, Grand Rapids, MI: design engineer prepared a three-dimensional finite element analysis of the spillway structure for the Cascade dam. The spillway structure, constructed in the 1920's, consisted of four bays with upstream inclined, barrel arches and downstream arch rollway. The spillway was supported by exterior and interior piers and the pier footings were tied laterally with several grade beams and a thin slab-on-grade. The analysis of the entire structure was provided to support the 2002 FERC Part 12 inspection.
- Tainter Gate Analysis and Modifications, Ukiah, CA: design engineer prepared a three-dimensional finite element analysis of the Tainter gate located on the low level outlet of the Lake Mendocino dam. The gate is used to divert water into the hydroelectric facility. Recommendations were provided to modify the gate to handle operational stresses. The analysis of the gate was provided to support FERC relicensing. Upon approval from FERC, Scott prepared design plans and specifications to reinforce the tainter gate arms and modify the top seal to allow for gate operation under hydrostatic & hydrodynamic head at full reservoir level. He also prepared a transient pressure analysis for approval of maximum flow during gate operation. Scott assisted the City of Ukiah and NCPA in obtaining USACE approval for the design modifications and planned operations of the tainter gate.
- FERC Part 12 Dam Safety Inspections, Various Locations, CA: engineer assisting with FERC Part 12 Dam Safety Inspections. His responsibilities included preparing STID and CSIR reports, participating in PFMA sessions, performing field inspections, performing and reviewing stability analyses, monitoring equipment measurements, determination of spillway adequacy to pass the IDF, writing final inspection reports, and project coordination. He assisted on the following FERC Part 12 Inspections:
 - Upper and lower Utica dams, Northern California Power Agency, CA
 - Camp Far West Dam, South Sutter Water District, CA
 - Rock Creek and Cresta dams, Pacific Gas & Electric, CA
 - Iron Canyon and McCloud dams, Pacific Gas & Electric, CA


I am interested in serving on the City of Sacramento's Utility Rate Advisory Commission because of my extensive involvement in utilities matters over the past couple of decades. As a prior consultant to the California State Assembly Utilities and Commerce Committee, (from 1987 – 1990 and 1998 – 2000) I have been involved in drafting, analyzing and monitoring several legislative initiatives that impact the utilities programs throughout the state of California in general and in the City of Sacramento, in particular.

The City of Sacramento is currently engaged in implementing its water meter installation program pursuant to legislation approved by the California State Legislature and signed by the Governor in 2004. Additionally the City is exploring programs and initiatives to help the City become a leader in ensuring a greener environment for our community. The City of Sacramento has also been restructuring some of its service programs due to significant budget cuts.

I have worked with the California Department of Conservation, Division of Recycling providing technical assistance in developing regulations to implement Assembly Bill 87, Statutes of 1992, Chapter 1266. Assembly Bill 87 established the Handling Fee Payment Program to replace the Convenience Incentive Payment Program. I also assisted the Division in drafting emergency implementing regulations for submission to the Office of Administrative Law for processing fees and lead the Division's efforts in the development of regulatory provisions and the Initial Statement of Reasons for handling fees.

Also, as staff to the California State Assembly, I was involved in staffing several significant pieces of legislation aimed at assisting low income utility customers, ensuring a dedicated funding source for California's largest utilities' energy and conservation activities, public interest research and development, and the operation and development of existing, new and emerging renewable energy resources. I have continued to be engaged in the policies aimed at reducing greenhouse gas emissions.

It gives me great pleasure to write this letter of recommendation for Carolyn Veal-Hunter to serve on the City of Sacramento's Utilities Rate Advisory Commission (URAC). 




I am interested in serving on the City of Sacramento's Utility Rate Advisory Commission because of my extensive involvement in utilities matters over the past couple of decades. As a prior consultant to the California State Assembly Utilities and Commerce Committee, (from 1987 – 1990 and 1998 – 2000) I have been involved in drafting, analyzing and monitoring several legislative initiatives that impact the utilities programs throughout the state of California in general and in the City of Sacramento, in particular.

The City of Sacramento is currently engaged in implementing its water meter installation program pursuant to legislation approved by the California State Legislature and signed by the Governor in 2004. Additionally the City is exploring programs and initiatives to help the City become a leader in ensuring a greener environment for our community. The City of Sacramento has also been restructuring some of its service programs due to significant budget cuts.

I have worked with the California Department of Conservation, Division of Recycling providing technical assistance in developing regulations to implement Assembly Bill 87, Statutes of 1992, Chapter 1266. 
