

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-447

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

June 20, 2006

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR THE ANNUAL EXTENSION OF NONPROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT (CM2005-0723) WITH JACKSON ELECTRIC IN THE AMOUNT OF \$73,980.

BACKGROUND

Bids were received and award was made to Jackson Electric for Maintenance of Street Lighting (re-lamping) in June 2005. This agreement for an annual amount of \$72,528 expires June 30, 2006. In exhibit A, section 4, there is an option to extend with a minimum annual increase of two percent (2%). Work performance has been good and there is still a need for night contract work.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute the supplemental agreement for the annual extension of nonprofessional services agreement (CM2005-0723) with Jackson Electric in the amount of \$73,980.

Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute the nonprofessional services agreement for crack sealing at various locations with Bond Blacktop Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$250,000, annually.


