AWARD CONTRACT FOR THE MEADOWVIEW UTILITY STORAGE YARD RELOCATION PROJECT (PN: XI66)

BACKGROUND

- A. The City needs to reconstruct a storage yard, adjacent to the Freeport reservoir, in order to make room for the Freeport Regional Water Authority (FRWA) Intake Structure. FRWA has paid the City \$775,000 to relocate the facilities, as part of the Sales and Purchase agreement approved by the City Council on October 11, 2005.
- B. The Utilities Department prepared construction documents for the relocation project and advertised for bids. C & C construction is the lowest responsible bidder for the project

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The contract specifications for the Meadowview Utility Storage Yard Relocation Project (PN: XI66, Fund 414) are approved and the contract is awarded to C&C Construction, for an amount not to exceed \$715,768.

Secton 2 The City Manager is authorized to execute such contract on behalf of the City.


