**APPROVING THE MITIGATION AGREEMENT FOR THE GIANT GARTER SNAKE
HABITAT IMPACTED BY THE UEDA PARKWAY PROJECT, CIP HB19**

BACKGROUND

- A. The Ueda Parkway is an important part of a regional trail system that offers both recreation and commuter opportunities.
- B. An environmental review of the project area determined 4.71 acres of giant garter snake habitat is being impacted and have mitigation requirements associated with the Ueda Parkway project.
- C. To fulfill mitigation requirements, staff proposes purchasing covered species conservation credits from Gilsizer Slough, LLC. The cost of credits is \$35,000 per acre.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. An agreement is approved with Gilsizer Slough, LLC, for \$164,850 of mitigation credits for Ueda Parkway Phase I, CIP HB19.
