

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-600

EXTENDING THE TIME TO COMPLETE THE CONDITIONS OF VACATION REQUIRED BY RESOLUTION, 2003-578, REGARDING THE VACATION OF THE SOUTH HALF OF ASCOT AVENUE BOUNDED BY DRY CREEK ROAD AND ACME AVENUE

VACATION PROCEEDING NO. VP06-08

BACKGROUND

- A. On August 19, 2003, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2003-578 authorizing the vacation of the south half of Ascot Avenue bounded by Dry Creek Road and Acme Avenue upon completion of certain conditions by SAFCA by August 19, 2005. Resolution 2003-578 was to become void if the conditions were not completed by August 19, 2005 unless the City Council granted a time extension.
- B. On August 16, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2003-578 extending the time to complete the conditions required by Resolution No. 2003-578 for one additional year. All conditions were to be completed by August 19, 2006.
- C. SAFCA requests an additional one year extension to complete the conditions of abandonment stated in Resolution No. 2003-578.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The time for Sacramento Area Flood Control Agency to complete the conditions of vacation required by Resolution No. 2003-578 is extended from August 19, 2006 to August 19, 2007.




