**ESTABLISHING THE FORT NATOMAS AT JEFFERSON PARK
CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM**

BACKGROUND

- A. On Monday evening, June 26th, an arson fire destroyed the community-designed and built Leathers & Associates playground equipment in Jefferson Park in South Natomas
- B. Staff is working with the community volunteers to determine the scope, budget and timeline for rebuilding.
- C. It is requested that an initial \$100,000 from Park Impact Fee, Fund 791, be appropriated to aid with the design of the facility.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. That a new Capital Improvement Program for improvements to Fort Natomas at Jefferson Park, CIP LQ66, is established..
- Section 2. That \$100,000 from Park Impact Fee, Fund 791, is appropriated to CIP LQ66.




