

## RESOLUTION NO. 2006-627

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

August 22, 2006

### RECITING THE FACTS OF THE PRIMARY MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON JUNE 6, 2006, DECLARING THE RESULTS AND OTHER SUCH MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW

#### BACKGROUND

- A. A Primary Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Sacramento, California on Tuesday, June 6, 2006, as required by law.
- B. Notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the voted were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Election Code of the State of California.
- C. Pursuant to Resolution No. 2005-907 adopted December 13, 2005, the Sacramento County Office of Voter Registration and Elections canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to this City Council; the results are received, attached and made part hereof as "Exhibits A and B".

#### BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. That the whole number of ballots cast in Districts 1, 3, 5 and 7 (including write-in, over and under votes) was 40,034.
- Section 2. That the names of persons voted for at the election for Members of the City Council are as follows:

#### Council District 1

Raymond Tretheway - 7,803 (100%)

#### Council District 3

Steve Cohn - 7,958 (75%)

Bruce Pomer - 2,697 (25%)

#### Council District 5

Lauren Hammond - 4,527 (77%)  
LR Roberts - 1,382 (23%)

**Council District 7**

Robbie Waters - 7,175 (100%)

- Section 3. That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the District to each of the persons above named for the respective offices for which the persons were candidates, are as listed in "Exhibits A and B" attached.
- Section 4. The City Council does declare and determine that: Raymond Tretheway III was elected as Member of the City Council District 1 for a full term of four years; Steve Cohn was elected as Member of the City Council District 3 for a full term of four years; Lauren Hammond was elected as Member of the City Council District 5 for a full term of four years; Robbie Waters was elected as Member of the City Council District 7 for a full term of four years.
- Section 5. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City, a statement of the result of the election, showing: 1. The whole number of ballots cast in the Districts; 2. The names of the persons voted for; 3. For what office each person voted; 4. The number of votes given at each precinct to each person; and 5. The total number of voted given to each person.
- Section 6. That the City Clerk shall on November 28, 2006, and pursuant to City Charter Section 153, make and deliver to each of the persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated; that the City Clerk shall also administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the office of the City Clerk. Each and all persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.
- Section 7. That the City Clerk shall certify the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.


