### **Description/Analysis**

**Issue:** Each year, the City of Sacramento and the County of Sacramento fund  
the Human Rights/Fair Housing Commission, a joint powers authority. Funding  
for the Commission is provided from the City, the County, the Sacramento  
Housing and Redevelopment Agency (SHRA), the Small Claims Court Advisory  
Clinic and other sources.

**Policy Considerations:** Approval of this agreement will fund various programs  
currently being offered by the Commission in the City of Sacramento.

**Environmental Considerations:** None. Under CEQA guidelines, continuing  
administrative activities do not constitute a project and are therefore exempt from  
review.


**Rationale for Recommendation:** As part of the development of the FY 2005-06

\$133,100.




**Financial Considerations:** The \$133,100 cost of this agreement is included in the FY 2006-07 budget.
