**SERVICE AGREEMENT: HUMAN RIGHTS/FAIR
HOUSING COMMISSION FY 2006-2007**

BACKGROUND

- A. The Human Rights/Fair Housing Commission is a Joint Powers Authority of the City of Sacramento and the County of Sacramento. Funding is provided from the City, the County, the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency (SHRA) the Small Claims Court Advisory Clinic and other sources.
- B. As part of the development of the FY 2005-06 budget, staff met with Commission, County and Agency staff to evaluate all Commission programs on cost, services provided and effectiveness. As a result, staff recommended funding support of \$133,100. Staff is recommending the same level of funding for FY 2006-2007, which is included in the budget.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Human Rights/Fair Housing Commission Agreement for Fiscal Year 2006-2007 in the amount of \$133,100.
