**SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT #1 WITH KENNEDY/JENKS CONSULTANTS
FOR ENGINEERING DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OVERSIGHT FOR OLD
ELVAS GRAVEL QUARRY LANDFILL (ST. FRANCIS) PROJECT YA08.**

BACKGROUND

- A. The City of Sacramento entered into a settlement agreement with the Roman Catholic Bishop of Sacramento to design, permit, construct, install and operate an approved methane gas control and monitoring system.
- B. On November 9, 2004 City Council approved a Professional Services Agreement # 2004-0174 in the amount of \$168,000 with Kennedy/Jenks Consulting to design, assist with the bid process for construction and coordinate the quality assurances and quality controls during construction of the methane gas control and monitoring system.
- C. Due to unforeseen circumstances and required additional work not anticipated in the original scope of the above mentioned agreement a budget amendment of \$92,500 is requested to complete the project successfully and meet the additional requirements of the State and Local Enforcement Agency.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to sign and execute the supplemental agreement with Kennedy/Jenks Consultants in the amount of \$92,500, increasing the total contract amount from \$168,000 to \$260,500 for the Old Elvas Gravel Quarry Landfill (St. Francis) Project YA08


Adopted by the City of Sacramento City Council on October 17, 2006 by the following vote:
