APPROVING THE 2006 PARKS AND RECREATION PROGRAMMING GUIDE

BACKGROUND

- A. In 2001, the City Council adopted a process to develop a *Parks and Recreation Programming Guide* (PRPG).
- B. The City of Sacramento's Parks and Recreation Programming Guide is designed to identify, evaluate and prioritize unfunded park and recreation projects.
- C. The PRPG process ensures that the City Council and community are strategically involved in the development of comprehensive list of unfunded project needs and those needs are prioritized based on City Council policy and deficiencies identified in the *Parks and Recreation Master Plan*.
- D. On March 22, 2005, the City Council approved the process and criteria for the development of the 2006 Parks and Recreation Programming Guide.
- E. On August 16, 2005, the City the City Council approved the Acreage and Facility Deficiencies used for scoring projects identified in the 2006 Parks and Recreation Programming Guide.
- F. Over the past year, staff contacted all of the City's neighborhood associations requesting new project ideas, attended more than 30 community and neighborhood association meetings, held a number of public workshops and presented numerous updated to both the PRC and City Council.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The 2006 Parks and Recreation Programming Guide is approved.


