

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-790

DETERMINING PROJECT EXEMPT FROM REVIEW UNDER THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CREATION AND AUTHORITY OF A DESIGN COMMISSION AND A PRESERVATION COMMISSION (M06-017))

BACKGROUND

- A. The City of Sacramento's Environmental Planning Services has reviewed the Ordinances creating a Design Commission and a Preservation Commission and establishing notice and hearing authority and procedures for design and preservation review (M06-017) ("Project") and has determined the Project is exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act as follows:
1. The Project is exempt under the following provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act and/or Guidelines: Section 15061(b)(3) Review and Exemption, and Section 15378(b)(5) Definitions.
 2. The factual basis for the finding of exemption is as follows: The proposed ordinances do not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment due to the organizational and administrative activities of City government that are involved, realizing however that subsequent actions or decisions made pursuant to these ordinances, once adopted, may be required to undergo environmental review.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Council has reviewed and considered the Environmental Planning Services determination of exemption and the comments received at the hearing on the Project and determines that the Project is exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act for the reasons stated above.


