

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-796

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

October 31, 2006

ACCEPT THE CONSTRUCTION PROPOSAL FROM INTELLIGENT TECHNOLOGIES AND AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH INTELLIGENT TECHNOLOGIES TO PROVIDE CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR THE DISCOVERY MUSEUM FIRE ALARM SYSTEM RE-BID PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$164,026.

BACKGROUND

- A. Public safety concerns brought forth over the past year by Discovery Museum staff regarding the old age of the fire alarm system, lack of available repair parts and the inadequate floor detection area coverage.
- B. Staff is recommending the immediate replacement of the fire alarm system at the Discovery Museum Gold Rush History Center in Old Sacramento.
- C. The focus of this project is the safety of the Museum staff, the general public as visitors to the Museum and preservation of priceless artifacts from our City's past that are housed and on display in the Museum.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The construction proposal from Intelligent Technologies is hereby accepted.
- Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a contract with Intelligent Technologies in the amount not to exceed \$164,026 to provide construction services for the Discovery Museum Fire Alarm System Re-bid project.
