**REJECTION OF BID FOR THE SUMP 42
IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (PN: XI36)**

BACKGROUND

- A. Sump 42 is a sewer lift station operated by the City of Sacramento that conveys sewage from Basin 42 to the Sacramento Regional Treatment plant.
- B. The Sump 42 Improvements project was advertised for bidding and only one bid was received on October 11, 2006.
- C. The bid received exceeded the engineer's estimate by over 38%, and also exceeds the project budget.
- D. Rejecting this bid will allow the project to be rebid. Staff will provide additional notice regarding the second request for bids, to increase the likelihood of receiving multiple bids and increase the likelihood of future bids coming in closer to the engineer's estimate.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The bid received on October 11, 2006 for the Sump 42 Improvements Project (PN: XI36) is rejected so that the project may be readvertised.
