
Subject: Proposed Sphere of Influence Amendment – Camino Norte

This letter is to advise LAFCo that pursuant to Government Code Section 56425, staff from the County of Sacramento has met with staff from the City of Sacramento on the proposed Sphere of Influence Amendment for the project described as Camino Norte. Camino Norte is located immediately north of I-80, east of El Centro Road, south of San Juan Road and west of the Natomas West Drain Canal. In addition, this area includes property lying east of El Centro Road near Leona Circle. These areas are consistent with the Natomas Joint Vision MOU reached between the city and county.

County staff has reviewed the proposed Sphere of Influence boundary, development standards, and zoning requirements as required during the meet and confer process. County staff does not have any objections with the City of Sacramento submitting a Sphere of Influence Amendment application to LAFCo for the property described above.


In light of the pending resolution of issues related to the "boot" area, the county has not taken a position on any proposed Sphere of Influence Amendment lying west of El Centro Road. There are several issues including the one mile buffer location that need to be resolved. Therefore, the County does not support a Sphere of Influence Amendment for these areas at this time.
