

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-873

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

AWARD A CONSULTANT SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH WEST YOST AND ASSOCIATES FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE SOUTH SACRAMENTO RESERVOIR PROJECT (PN: ZL66)

BACKGROUND

- A. The City has repeatedly experienced low water pressure during the summer months in the south east portion of the water distribution system. The 2005 water distribution system master plan recommended a total of 15 million gallons of additional storage to be constructed in the City by 2030. A reservoir is needed in the southern portion of the City to provide water during peak hour demands, fire demands and emergencies.
- B. Staff recommends the selection of West Yost and Associates to prepare the Design and Construction Bidding Documents. The complete project cost, including construction costs, is estimated to be \$8 million.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to(1) execute a Consultant Services Agreement with West Yost and Associates for Design of the South Sacramento Reservoir Project (PN: ZL66) for an amount not to exceed \$499,586 and (2) transfer \$4,000 (Fund 413) from the Southeast Sacramento Transmission Main Project (ZK91) to ZL66.


