

## RESOLUTION NO. 2006-878

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

December 5, 2006

### REJECTION OF BIDS FOR THE SUMP 154 OUTFALL LINING PROJECT (PN: WE23)

#### BACKGROUND

- A. Sump 154 is a drainage lift station operated by the City of Sacramento that conveys drainage from Basin 154 to Arcade Creek.
- B. The Sump 154 Outfall Lining Project was advertised for bidding on September 8<sup>th</sup>, and three bids were received and opened on September 27<sup>th</sup>, 2006.
- C. The lowest bid significantly exceeded the engineer's estimate and project fund balance.
- D. Rejecting these bids will allow alternative lining methods and/or technologies to be evaluated, with the intent of obtaining future bids within budget.

#### BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The bids received on September 27, 2006 for the Sump 154 Outfall Lining Project (PN: WE23) are rejected.

Adopted by the City of Sacramento City Council on December 5, 2006 by the following vote: -




