**SUPPORTING MCKINLEY PARK IRRIGATION INFRASTRUCTURE
IMPROVEMENTS AS A CONCEPT PROJECT FOR THE
PROPOSITION 50 URBAN WATER USE EFFICIENCY PROGRAM**

BACKGROUND:

- A. In November 2002, California voters passed Proposition 50, the Water Security Clean Drinking Water, Coastal and Beach Protection Act of 2002.
- B. The Proposition 50 Urban Water Use Efficiency Grant Program funds projects that are not locally cost effective, and that provide water savings or in-stream flows that are beneficial to the Bay-Delta or the rest of the state.
- C. Irrigation infrastructure improvements were identified as a "priority" area of rehabilitation in the adopted *2006 Parks and Recreation Programming Guide (PRPG)*.
- D. Staff in the development of this proposal assessed the facilities in PRPG that would qualify for this funding and identified as the "worst-first" in need of infrastructure improvements as McKinley Park.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. Supports irrigation infrastructure improvements at McKinley Park as the concept project for the Proposition 50 Urban Water Use Efficiency Program.


