**PROPOSED CHANGES TO ORDINANCES CREATING DESIGN
COMMISSION AND PRESERVATION COMMISSION (M06-017)**

BACKGROUND

Staff is seeking a Resolution to direct staff to prepare for Council consideration, specific changes to Chapter 17 of Title 17 of the Sacramento City Code relating to the Design Commission and Preservation Commission to allow for appointment of commissioners requiring specific professional qualifications and / or experience who neither own a business in the City nor are residents of Sacramento. This would potentially allow the appointment of qualified professional Commissioners from outside the City to serve on each of these two commissions.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Staff is directed to initiate the necessary amendments to Title 17 of the Sacramento City Code (the Zoning Code) relating to the Design Commission and Preservation Commission to facilitate appointment of professionally qualified and experienced commissioners who are neither Sacramento residents nor business owners in the City.


