

## RESOLUTION NO. 2007-016

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

January 9, 2007

### SELECTION OF PROJECTS TO SUBMIT TO SACOG FOR FUNDING

#### BACKGROUND

- A. In December 2006, SACOG announced that it would program one year of funding from the federal transportation act, and the funds available from an augmentation to the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).
- B. SACOG estimates that about \$106 million will be available for this programming exercise. The process calls for distributing most of the funds under the following three programs: Regional Scale Projects; Locally Identified; and Road Rehabilitation projects.

#### BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following list of projects is approved for submission to SACOG and STA for federal and state funds. The cost estimates may change as staff further refines the estimates.


